Dear Sir/Madam,

I-Coats N.V. guarantees that our products currently supplied are Reach¹ conform. I-Coats supplies preparations (mixture of substances) and not substances (we are active in the "mixture chemistry" and not in the "reaction chemistry"). Preparations cannot be (pre)registered, only substances can.

We, hereby, confirm that the substances mentioned in the Candidate List of Very High Concern of the REACH statement (updated 04 July 2022) which is published in accordance with Article 59 (10), are not used for more than 0.1% by weight in the composition of the preparations or articles that we supply.

Furthermore, to the best of our knowledge the chemicals on the current Californian Proposition 65 List2 (25/02/2022), the chemicals on the Annexes EU 2019/1021 (POP Guideline) or the chemicals on the Stockholm convention list (UN) of 17 June 2022 are not used in our preparations.

Also none of the chemicals on the Swiss ChemRevv (dated 6 october 2022) are not used in our preparations.

Consequently we do not routinely analyse these substances. For as far as we can judge and with the information at hand, we don't foresee that any of our products will disappear because of Reach or the other regulations mentioned here. Should this situation change, we will inform our customers.

Our products are not explosive, not inflammable, not toxic, not radioactive, not corrosive, not oxidising and do not contain any biological reactive substances classified as dangerous under the I.A.T.A. standards or A.D.R. regulation.
